At the Family Resource Center, we offer a safe haven for more than 200 children throughout the year, ages 4-13, through after-school programs and summer education enrichment.

SERVICES

Summer Enrichment

Our summer programs provide a place for structured activities to keep youth engaged in active learning while school is out of session. In the summer, we provide learning opportunities and enrichment for our children that they would otherwise not experience.

Nutrition

During the school year, we provide a nutritious complete dinner for all after-school students. In summer, the children are given two meals a day plus two snacks. All meals meet federal standards.

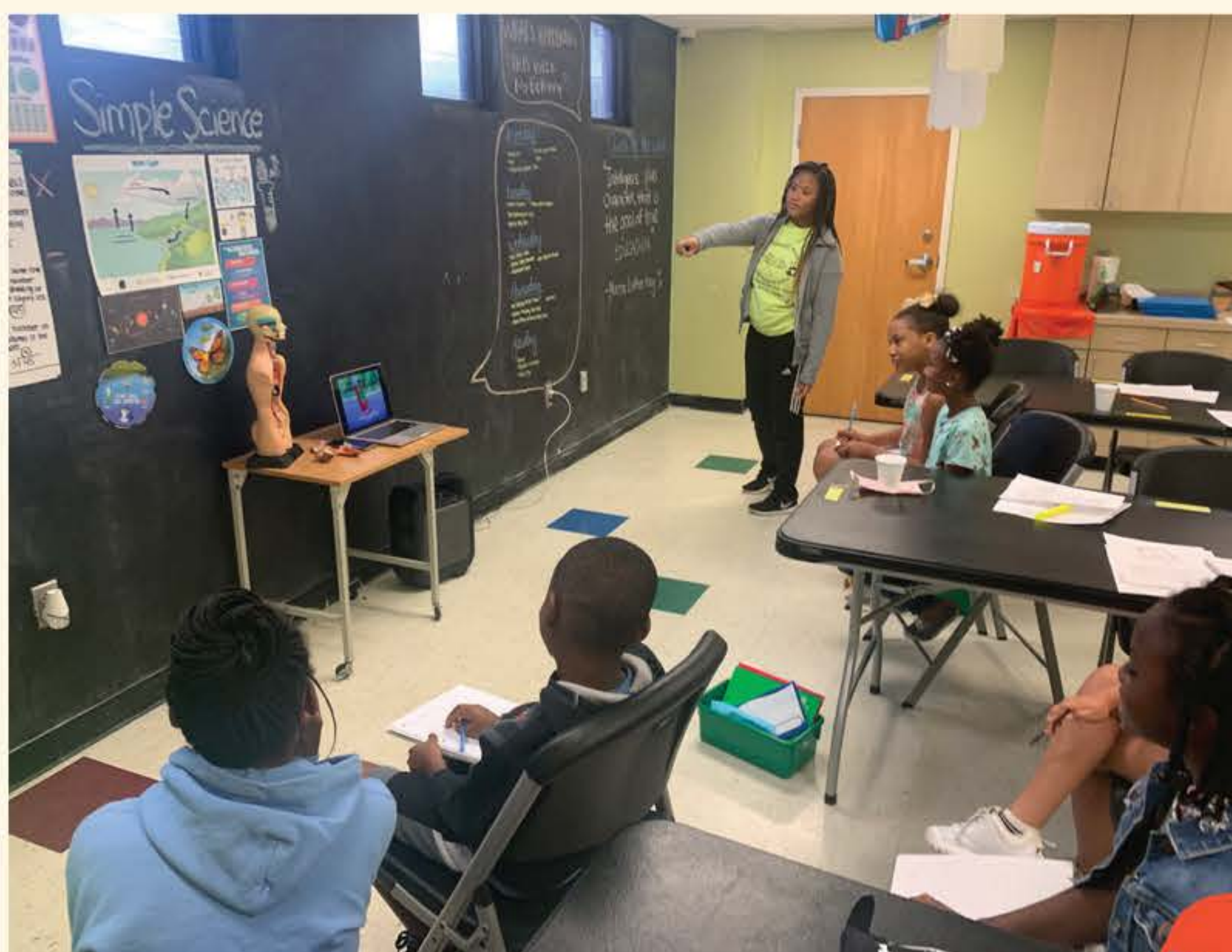
Reading Program

Reading is a key predictor in educational success. We help children with schoolwork and skill development. Staff members tutor during the school year as part of our after-school program and serve as positive role models. Our certified Reading teachers work with children after school, as part of our Summer and After-School Literacy program. Reading skills are critical to these children's future success, and we want them to appreciate the value of reading at an early age. Reading should become something they want to do. More reading leads to better writing, spelling, grammar, and a larger vocabulary.

STEM - Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics

The Family Resource Center works with the students in the STEM program. The principles of science teach children life skills such as perseverance, problem solving, and researching.



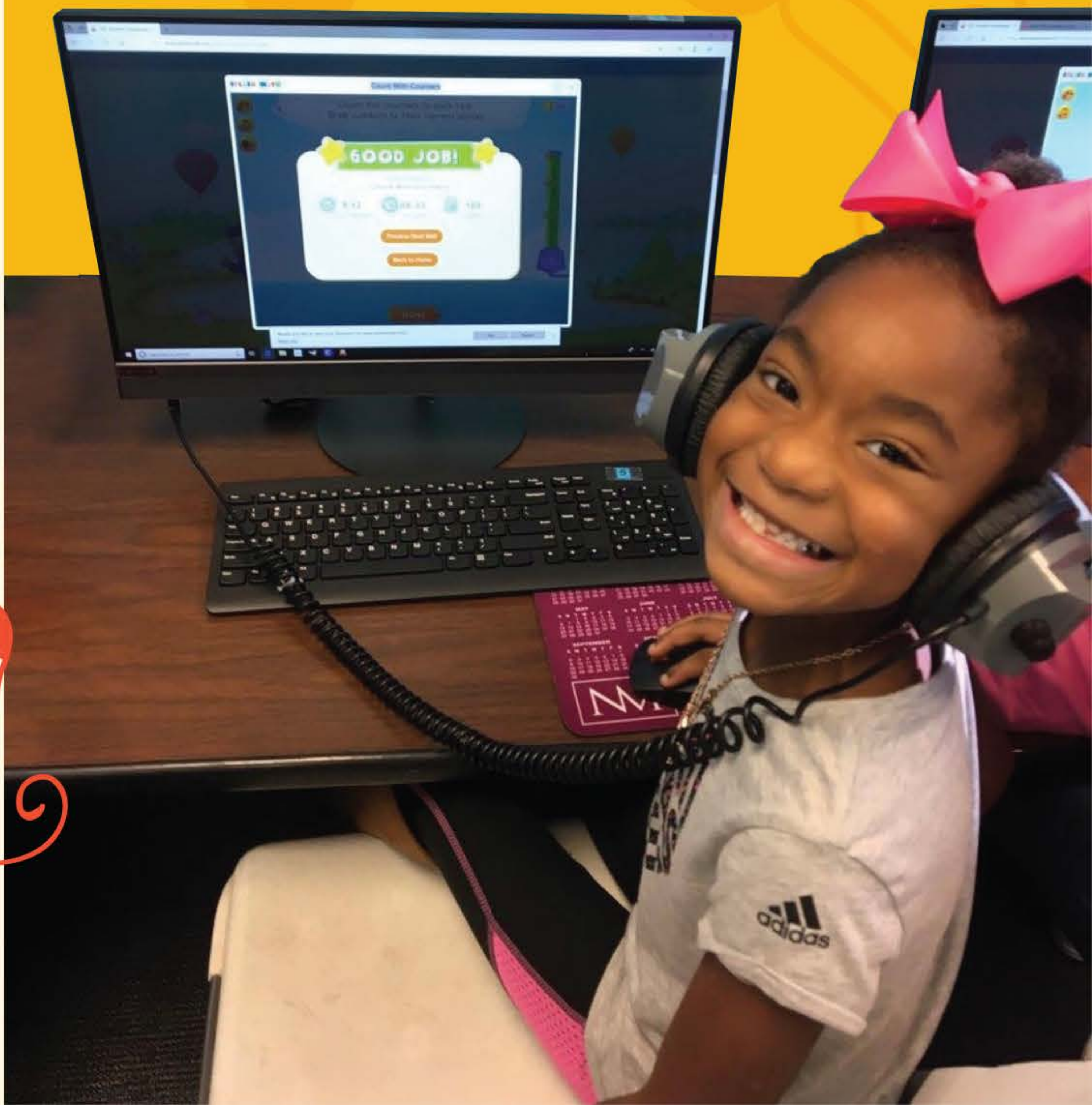

UPDATED COMPUTER LAB

To support our STEM program, we recently upgraded our computer lab with twenty new computers. Many of our children do not have computers at home. For some of these students, our Center acts as their main or only access to computers. Thanks to our new computers and software, children are able to learn up-to-date technology skills that they will need to succeed. We want children to develop positive attitudes towards technology. This is more important than ever due to the growing prevalence of online learning. During the school year, our teachers and staff assist our students as they progress through the different online STEM programs.

Q: Are you part of CCCS?

A: \$75/week during the school year. \$95/week during the summer.

Q: What ages do you accept?

A: 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Q: Do you ever provide scholarships?

A: Yes we provide need based scholarships and utilize a sliding scale to determine tuition.

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
